

Director of Instructional Support

(Start Date – July 1, 2010)

The Director of Instructional Support is responsible for the administration of all **special education** programs and other instructional support programs. Instructional support includes special education, guidance, gifted/talented, substance abuse counselor, social workers, school nurses, educational technicians, student assistance teams, 504 programs, intervention programs, ELL, and other contracted services.

The candidate should have the ability to facilitate collaborative problem-solving and inspire responsible risk taking, and have outstanding knowledge of current special education issues, strong conflict resolution skills, knowledge about performance based assessment, and effective human relations and communication skills.

To be considered for this position, **candidates must be certified or be eligible for certification as a Special Education Administrator in the State of Maine.**

Interested candidates need to submit one complete packet of information, which includes the following: completed application, letter of interest, resume, transcripts, and three letters of reference no later than 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 1, 2010. Candidates selected for an interview will be notified by April 9, 2010.
