## Problem-Solving & Planning: Responding to Dangerous Behavior

Join Amanda Wilson, EdS, NCSP, BCBA as she brings school leaders together to share experiences, collaborate, & grow their skillset in developing appropriate individualized responses plans that focus on prevention & effective responses to dangerous behaviors. Participants will have the opportunity to engage w/ other leaders about their experiences and needs relating to the implementation of recent state regulations pertaining to dangerous behavior.

This workshop, applicable to school leaders at the elementary & secondary levels, will provide participants with information & skills to better understand behavior. To improve development & appropriateness of individualized response plans, participants will learn to identify & analyze challenging routines which have resulted in dangerous behaviors. Analyzing challenging routines will assist school leaders in identifying factors that lead to dangerous behavior & preventative supports to put into place. Finally, participants will learn effective responses to problem behaviors to regulate, reflect, restore, & re-engage the student in their learning environment. Throughout the workshop, the importance of a team approach, consistency across staff w/ interventions, & building capacity for preventative supports will be highlighted. Resources, including a guide to developing a response plan, will be provided to assist participants in planning & implementing taught information.

Follow up topics:

- Considering both short & long-term student behavioral needs
- Ensuring staff safety
- Further discussion on the intersection of special education/IEP team determinations relating to placement & FBA/BIPs
- Barriers to implementation from previous session
- Ensuring consistent implementation of response plans
- Ensuring school morale & school safety
- Identifying staff training needs (who to train & how to train)
- The role & importance of continued tier 1 & 2 supports
- Other topics obtained from previous sessions, as needed
