## MADSEC CONSTITUTION

## Article VII - Officers

The officers of the Association shall also be known collectively as the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE and shall be as follows: President, President-Elect, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and immediate Past President. All officers shall be elected according to established procedures and assume office at the beginning of the fiscal year and continue until the close of the fiscal year of their elected terms.

## C. Vice President

The Vice- President shall serve for one year, assuming the office of President-Elect the following year. In the event a vacancy occurs in the office of the Vice-President, the President shall nominate and the Representative Board shall appoint an Active Member to the position for the duration of the year.
